TEMPORARY FILLING

- Congratulations on deciding to save your tooth, and we hope your tooth lasts a lifetime! The Root Canal procedure you had performed is the first step in returning your tooth to full form and function.
- As a courtesy, we have provided you with a temporary filling at no charge
- It is normal to feel rough, or “dished out” surfaces on a temporary filling.
- If you believe your temporary is biting “high” or the temporary filling has fallen completely out, please return to our office.
- Use caution while eating or clenching your teeth, especially while taking pain meds. You may generate excessive forces that only a properly crowned tooth can handle.
- Please appoint to see your general dentist within the next few weeks, even if the tooth feels a little sore.

Waiting too long to permanently restore your tooth may allow for bacteria to re-contaminate the root canal and allow for fractures to develop or propagate.
